Frog's Leap Sauvignon Blanc 2018, Napa Valley - *Organically Grown, California Certified Organic Farmers (CCOF), Sustainable, LEED Silver Certified*

In the 40 years of producing a world renowned Sauvignon Blanc, we've stayed true to the ideals we laid out at the very beginning. We have enhanced the wine and reinforced our ideals with stainless steel fermentation to preserve freshness, organically-certified and dry farmed vineyards to deepen our connection with the soil; predominantly estate grown fruit is used, allowing us to fine-tune the vines to our liking; brief skin contact and aging on the lees to give depth and complexity.

This Napa Valley Sauvignon Blanc is lovely with stone fruit, crisp apple, and wonderfully bright mineral flavors.



Loveblock Sauvignon Blanc 2019, Marlborough, NZ - *Certified Organic and Vegan Friendly*

Our Loveblock Farm, the anchor Estate Vineyard in Marlborough's Awatere Valley is *certified organic by BioGro New Zealand*. We incorporate methods that are centuries old such as composting to promote biodiversity and build soil, but we draw from modern technology and equipment to make the vineyards more carbon efficient. The basis of organic farming is rich, robust, fertile soil and healthy, balanced vines through proactive management of plant, microbial and insect biodiversity. Organics encourages the use of diverse plantings and insect life, but permits only naturally derived plant protection products. The use of synthetic chemical products (soluble fertilizer, pesticides, herbicides) is prohibited.

This New Zealand Sauvignon Blanc shows expressive bouquet of pineapple, guava and sweet meadow grass aromas. The texture is rounded with tropical fruit and notes of sweet basil, leading into hints of ripe peach on the back palate.



St. Supéry Oak Free Chardonnay 2018, Napa Valley Estate - *Napa Green Certification*

St. Supéry Estate Vineyards and Winery achieved a *Napa Green Land certification* in 2008 and *Napa Green Winery designation* in 2012. *Napa Green* is a comprehensive environmental certification program for vineyards and wineries in the Napa Valley. The program represents a soil-to-bottle approach to environmental stewardship and winemaking, integrating holistic management practices at every step of the process. Independent, third-party certification of farms and winemaking facilities makes *Napa Green* one of the most comprehensive environmental accreditations in the wine industry, requiring continual improvement for renewal.

This Chardonnay shows a rich tropical aroma combining notes of apricot, cantaloupe, and ripe pear. The palate taste and texture continues with flavors of cantaloupe, apricot, with touches of ripe nectarine and lemon zest. Bright, fresh, and powerfully pleasing.



Left Coast Cellars "Truffle Hill" Chardonnay 2018, Willamette Valley - *LIVE Certified*

All our Estate vineyards are sustainably grown and hand tended. We use drip irrigation, solar energy to generate power, and plant cover crops for pollinators and beneficial insects. Left Coast Cellars is a *LIVE certified winery*. *LIVE* Wines are independently certified by the *International Organization for Biological Control (IOBC)* to meet strict international standards for environmental and socially responsible winegrowing and winemaking in the Pacific Northwest. *LIVE* certification is one of the most authoritative sustainability accreditations in the wine world. For wineries to make *LIVE* certification they must meet ten separate vineyard growing requirements and wine practices each year.

This Oregon Chardonnay shows rich aromatics of elderflowers, white pepper, and toffee, accompanied by fruitier aromas of lemon peel, peaches, and pears. This age worthy chardonnay offers up bright acidity, ripe kiwi fruit, a nectary mid-palate and spiced poached pears.





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Paul Dolan Cabernet Sauvignon 2017, Mendocino County - California Certified Organic Farmers, Vegan, Certified California Sustainable Winery

At Paul Dolan vineyards all of our wines are certified organically grown by *California Certified Organic Farmers (CCOF)*. We believe that soil is a living system that is sensitive to chemicals and over cultivation. We utilize organic farming practices such as cover crops & natural pest management (i.e. owls/beneficial insects), instead of toxic chemicals or fertilizers. Our sustainability efforts save ~9,000,000 gallons of water annually, compost ~13,000,000 pounds of organic matter annually and derive 60% of our energy from renewable sources.

Our 2017 Paul Dolan Cabernet Sauvignon is rich, regal, and layered, aromas of black currant, olive tapenade and licorice are followed by flavors of black cherry, liquor de cassis and carob.



Oakville Winery Zinfandel 2018, Oakville - Napa Valley - California Certified Organic Farmers

At Oakville Winery, we own and manage our vineyards with enough care to be certified by the *California Certified Organic Farmers (CCOF)* since 1991. The *CCOF* Organic standards promote and enhance biodiversity, biological cycles, and soil fertility while restoring, maintaining, and enhancing ecological harmony. The organic process is a catalyst for the growth of healthy, sustainable, and humane production systems.

This Zinfandel has an incredible balance between both sweet and spicy notes. On the nose aromas of black pepper, cedar, dill and anise are present. The palate confirms the flavors shown in the bouquet, with underlying dark berry fruit.



Shannon Ridge Reserve Zinfandel 2016, Lake County - Sustainable Practices

At Shannon Ridge, we live in harmony with Mother Nature. We continue our dedication in creating a family of wines where consumers rely on high quality wines at an affordable price. We are passionate about preserving our land, not only for great vineyard sites, but for the wild creatures which share our property. Our Sustainability Practices integrate a flock of sheep that clean the vineyards, remove excess canopy, and reduce the need for chemicals, while providing natural fertilizer. *"The Ovis Cycle"*, the vineyards feed the sheep, the sheep feed the vines; the lambs feed the people, people drink the wine and wear wool.

The Shannon Ridge Reserve Zinfandel opens up with a bouquet of blackberry pie, vanilla oak, and an earthy character note. The flavors are rich on the palate with complex milk chocolate, dark ripe fruits, balanced oak integration, and depth.



Frey Vineyards Biodynamic Zinfandel 2017, Mendocino - Demeter Biodynamic, USDA Organic

In 1996, Frey Vineyards produced the United States' first certified *Biodynamic* wine. Frey Vineyards' *Biodynamic* wines are made from our premium estate-grown fruit, fermented with native indigenous yeast and produced with no added sulfites. Our low impact winemaking techniques preserve and protect the terroir of the wine, highlighting the subtle flavors of the vineyard site and vintage. Because the wines are not manipulated to reach certain flavor profiles, each batch is unique to the fruit and farm. The result is a portfolio of wines that are pure, delicious, and mirror the richness and beauty of the land. All Frey *Biodynamic* wines are estate-grown and bottled in accordance with *Demeter Biodynamic and USDA Organic* regulations.

This is a quintessential Mendocino County Zinfandel, full of dense black cherry flavors, lively tannins, and a touch of subtle oak on the finish.
