G. D. Vayra Langhe Rosso 2018 \$15⁹⁹ **Save \$3**

The Langhe DOC Rosso is a blend of heirloom grape varieties. The 2018 wine is silky and elegant, with plenty of fruit tones and a mineral vibrant finish. The appearance has red crystal color with purple hues. The nose is rich with elegant notes of fresh red berries and red currant. Leading into the mid palate the wine shows a beautiful purity with fresh notes of strawberry, cherries, and blueberries. The easy style of this wine is enhanced by the pleasing texture, balance, and fruit.



G. D. Vayra Barbera d'Alba DOC 2018 \$22⁹⁹ **Save \$7**

The Vayra Barbera d'Alba is a blend of estate vineyards and hand selected sites. The production and aging process enhances the fragrance and perfume of the fruit's integrity. The 2018 nose is vibrant and combines vivid red and black fruits with sweet spices and aromatic herbs followed by hints of anise and graphite add complexity to the wine. The palate is succulent and incredibly layered, bright with elegant acidity, strawberries, cherries, white pepper and a long finish.



Mauro Molino Barbera d'Asti LeRadici DOCG 2018

The label represents the return to our “roots”, to the beauty, uniqueness, and typicality of place: the Monferrato hills. The LeRadici (meaning roots) vineyard is in the municipality of Costigliole d’Asti, one of the areas most devoted to the production of Barbera d’Asti. This wine expresses hints of cherry and red fruits alternating with spicy and floral hints. The Molino Barbera d’Asti has excellent structure and complexity with sweet and velvety tannins. The balance of fruit, character and complexity showcases the winery’s focus on quality and production.



Fattoria Carpineta Chiant Classic Fontalpino DOCG

Carpineta Fontalpino is dedicated to the appreciation of the Sangiovese grape, exalting its quality by selecting only the best grapes from our vineyards. The Fontalpino is a typical example of a pure Sangiovese, red with purple reflections, with interesting aromas of plum, cherry, and currant. It is persistent, pleasing and versatile with great balance and finish. This wine is produced from 100% Sangiovese, grown and produced in the region of Tuscany and aged up to 3 years.





Aia Vecchia Sor Ugo Bolgheri DOC Superiore 2017

As the winery's most important and awarded wine, Sor Ugo represents the elegance and strength of Bolgheri. A "Super Tuscan" Bordeaux-blend of Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Cabernet Franc, and Petit Verdot. This wine is bold and expressive, from the bouquet of dark red fruits and savory notes. As the wine opens on the palate the layered texture releases lush fruit, roasted coffee, and spice notes from the oak aging.



Fattoria Le Pupille Pian di Fiora

\$31⁹⁹ **Save \$6**

The wine shows a stunning crispness and a sharp focus in the 2016 vintage. It opens to black cherry notes and generous red fruit, with very lightly toasted almond and spice at the back. The mouthfeel is full, and while the bouquet starts off a bit closed, the finish grows steadily in volume and girth. The wine is produced in the appellation of Morellino di Scansano DOCG, from 90% Sangiovese and 10% Cabernet Sauvignon.
