These Autumn picks from our Cellar Masters and Staff are perfect pairings to enjoy with backyard barbecue, delicate seafood, charcuterie boards, desserts and outdoor gatherings inspired by cooler Fall weather.



B Wise Trios Cabernet Sauvignon 2019, Moon Mountain District, Sonoma Valley

This wine is driven by the Cabernet Sauvignon sourced from the Moon Mountain District Estate vineyard. Syrah, Cabernet Franc and Tannat bring both tension and texture to this superb wine. Cherry, raspberry, and cassis fruits lead the aromas from the bouquet to the palate. Medium to full-bodied with supporting notes of vanilla, anise, mineral, and oak lend character to supple tannins, texture and a dry finish.

Opolo Mountain Zinfandel 2019, Paso Robles

Exquisite notes of ripe cherries, plum, black raspberry, spice, and white pepper highlight the wines' central core of supple silky tannins. This Paso Robles Zinfandel maintains a medium-body, with well integrated and elegant streaks of lively acidity and balanced tannins.

Runquist Barbera 2019, Amador County

The aromas of this wine center on raspberry, cherry, and currant, along with notes of violets, lavender, vanilla, and nutmeg. The characteristic of Barbera is known for its brightness due to a little acidity in the grapes. This shows in its clear presences of red fruit flavors delivered with a creamy, smooth and round texture that transitions to an elegant finish with notes of mocha, caramel, and a gentle toasted oak.





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Austin Cabernet Sauvignon 2019, Paso Robles

True to Paso Robles' signature style, this fruit forward Cabernet Sauvignon has enticing aromas of dark fruit, fresh vanilla bean, and hints of coffee. The dark brooding fruit is balanced with savory notes of black pepper, baking spices and a touch of cocoa and sweet oak. Balanced with fruit, acidity and feathered tannins, this wine over delivers.



Domaine de la Bretonnière Muscadet Sèvre & Maine 2020

Lean and crisp with the classic salinity that makes Muscadet such a perfect match for seafood. Fresh, pithy citrus flavors, some barely ripe apple, and lime blossom with a soft, round texture from lees aging. Finishes with crisp precision and charming length.



King Estate Chardonnay 2019, Willamette Valley

Subtle notes of sweet French oak on the nose are immediately enhanced by tart apricot and succulent honeysuckle components. Accompanying this rich presentation are flavors of peach, lemon zest, wild honey, fresh baked bread, and vanilla.



House of Brown Chardonnay 2018

Notes of pineapple, flowering star jasmine, orange blossoms, and traces of honeysuckle, lemon verbena, and meringue. Light, crisp, elegant, and juicy on the palate with a bright yet round mouthfeel. Made from sustainably grown wine grapes. An easy drinking anytime, anywhere wine, always in season.



Pike Road Sparkling Rosé NV

This sparkling wine from Oregon showcases the focus and dedication in producing quality, well-crafted sparkling wines. The blend is primarily Chardonnay and Pinot Gris, with a splash of Riesling and Pinot Noir. The wine has a deeper rose color, yet the Sparkling Rosé has clean, fruit focused entry and palate. Showing fresh red berry notes and a pleasing mousseux, the wine finishes with a rounded body and finish.
